

Resolution on the Solidarity with Korea

Feeling a great anxiety about the aggravating military confrontation and tension on the Korean Peninsula due to the maneuvers of hostile forces including the United States to threaten peace and security on the Korean Peninsula

Recognizing that it is one of key issues for peace and security of Asia and the rest of the World to achieve the reunification, peace and stability on the Korean Peninsula today,

Welcoming that a bright future is opened for reunification, peace and prosperity of Korea by adoption of the June 15 Joint Declaration and the October 4 Declaration,

Emphasizing that the principle of equality of sovereignty clarified in the international laws including the United Nations Charter should be observed thoroughly in the international relations,

The Executive Committee Meeting of the World Peace Council declares as follows;

- The United States should give up the anachronistic hostile policy towards the DPRK and respond positively to the DPRK-US talks for normalization of relation with the DPRK.
- The Korean Armistice Agreement should be replaced by a solid peace mechanism, the US troops stationing in south Korea should be withdrawn and all the aggressive war exercises should be stopped.
- Korea should be reunified in independent and peaceful way based on the historic June 15 Joint Declaration and the October 4 Declaration which were recognized and supported by the United Nations General Assembly.
- Korea should be denuclearized and become a zone free from nuclear weapons
- We appeal to the peace-loving peoples and organizations of the world to widely launch the international solidarity activities to support the cause of justice of the Korean people in 2010 when will mark the 65th anniversary of the division of Korea by foreign forces, the 60th anniversary of the provocation of the Korean War and the 10th anniversary of the issuance of June 15 Joint Declaration.
